## A WORD ABOUT SUPER DOCTORS

When doctors get sick, whom do they call? If you or a loved one has special medical needs, wouldn't it be nice to know whom medical professionals trust and hold in the highest regard? You could ask them yourself. But to save you some time, we asked them for you.

Key Professional Media asked more than 40,000 medical professionals to nominate one or more doctors, other than themselves, from specified medical specialties based on one question: "If you needed medical care, which doctor would you choose?"

After tallying their replies, the research team also identified Texas doctors who had achieved special recognition from their peers or had demonstrated other indications of expertise in their specialties. The researchers also made sure each physician is properly licensed and has no history of disciplinary action.

In the end, Key Professional Media selected a list of Texas Super Doctors in 29 medical practice areas.

Does this list miss any outstanding Texas doctors? No list is perfect—and in the second-largest state in the union, we could never include all the great physicians out there. We also wouldn't suggest leaving your doctor because he or she didn't make the list. All the doctors practicing in Texas are required to comply with stringent licensing requirements.
